Players will be notified **via the web site** of their first scheduled ice time. All participants must check in at the registration tables before entering the locker rooms or ice surface. Full equipment is required, including skates, shin guards, hockey pants, protective cup, elbow pads, gloves, shoulder pads, an approved helmet with full face mask, hockey stick, and neck guard.
